Find something INTERESTING and COMPREHENSIBLE for you to read. Keep trying different materials until you find something that works for you. You are looking for... something that you like \& can understand; material that keeps your attention \& that you can read without struggle.

> PICK SOMETHING THAT IS:
> ENGAGING \& UNDERSTANDABLE to you
> ENJOYABLE \& RELATIVELY EASY for you PALATABLE \& ACCESSIBLE to you

- It does not have to be utterly fascinating, and you do not have to understand every single word.
- It should just hold your interest for a while, and it should be something that you can mostly understand.
- If you don't like it, or it doesn't make sense to you, choose something else to read next time.
- Reading the same book again may be a good option too.
